What is Spring Fling?

Spring Fling is on Saturday April 27th. It is our annual FUNraising, FUN day. The entire school community is invited to participate in the Walk-a-Thon, Live Music, Silent Auction, Drawing, Crazy Hair Booth, the Photo Booth, T-Shirt Tie Dying, Bake Sale & more. Hacienda’s yearly budget is over \$300,000. Spring Fling is a daylong event where we aim to raise at least 10% of those vital funds.

What is the Walk-a-Thon?

Every student will receive a packet full of information including a pledge form. The course is open for walking from 9:30am – 3:30pm. Kids and Parents: Please ASK FAMILY, FRIENDS, CO-WORKERS & NEIGHBORS FOR A PLEDGE per mile your child walks or a flat amount. Cash, Check and Credit Cards are gladly accepted. Every dollar gets us closer to covering the +\$300K HIPS annual budget. Collect flat pledges in the pre-registration period ending Wednesday, April 24th to earn rewards or encourage your student to walk farther by adding up the per mile pledges to be collected after the event by May 10th.

What is the Drawing? What items will there be?

Drawing opens at 9:30am and will close at 2pm. You do not need to be present to win. Some teachers offer a teacher time event — a special activity with your child. A ticket is \$5 and may be purchased before or during the event. The more tickets you enter, the higher chance you have of winning!

What is the Silent Auction? What items will there be?

There will be one huge round of auction items. Bidding begins at 9:30am and will close at 2pm. You do not need to be present to win. Most classrooms provide a themed class basket to be auctioned. BID HIGH, BID OFTEN!

How can you help before the event?

Even if you only have an hour or two, on campus or at home, we can use your help NOW. There are plenty more preparations to complete.

Will there be food & drinks?

What should you plan to bring?

The pledge card, comfortable shoes, sunscreen, a water bottle to refill at the drinking water station, a hat, a blanket to sit on the grass, an umbrella, folding chair, and cash or check for food, activities, and the Drawing.

Do I have to volunteer at this event?

This is a huge event and it takes many hands to make it successful. It is strongly encouraged for someone from each family to work a shift at the event. The sign up will be posted on Konstella on April 13th so keep an eye out. Volunteer as soon as possible.

Do I have to stay all day?

No, BUT the longer you are there the longer your student can walk, earn more pledge funds and have a great day!

Can I walk with my child?

Yes, anyone can walk. If they want to receive a lap card and earn medals, there is an \$8 fee and pick up at the registration table.
